However, Faultline's July 2021, was a wave of civil unrest in Kwa Zulu Natal and parts of Gauteng and saw a community under siege, facing new challenges.

Today, after thirty years of democracy, the Hindu community finds itself at a threshold amidst forced conversions, economic and financial challenges, family breakdown, confronting health issues and corruption, yet a deep resilience still prevails in the hearts of the Hindus-a beacon of light that yearns to be rekindled to grow once again.

WHO IS VISHWA HINDU PARISHAD

Vishwa Hindu Parishad is regarded as the largest Hindu organisation in Bharat and is engaged in many aspects of education, seva, advocacy, training and organizing the Hindu society.

It was first launched in 1964 by Swami Chinmayanandaji, Guruji Golwalker who was the second Sarsangachalak of RSS who presided over RSS for 33 years amongst other important Hindu leaders. Its main objective is to unite the entire Hindu society by galvanizing, strengthening and organizing them.

A wide range of Sants, Swamis, Acharyajis and Yogis came together to pave the way for organizing the Hindu society and in the process to network and build an informed and empowered society for the future. Over the years Vishwa Hindu Parishad grew to be established in several countries outside Bharat.

Vishwa Hindu Parishad -South Africa is a non-profit organization committed to supporting our society to help educate and inspire change through various activities, conducting Training and Education Sessions, Seva activities as well as engaging in HOTA activities-(Hindu Organisations and Temple Associations) to foster growth at the temple level.

The need for management principles for temples are key to expand the work of Hindu organisations. Temples must expand their services to cover such aspects as family health and well-being, youth development, business and propagation of Hindu Dharma. As learning centres of hope and light, temples must move beyond prayer to be innovative and impactful in society.



WHO IS THE WORLD HINDU FOUNDATION

The World Hindu Foundation is a facilitator organisation from VHP set to organize conferences that bring together sectors of Hindu society to network and map out future growth opportunity of the Hindu society. The World Hindu Congress held every 4 years is an instrument to organize the global Hindu community for Hindu resurgence. These are held to discuss issues of relevance and importance to the Global Hindu community and organizes 7 parallel conferences covering the areas of Economy, Education, Media, Politics, Youth, Women and Organisations together

- How we can support, uplift, educate our marginalized Hindus that face several challenges.




WHY THESE SESSIONS

There will be 8 sessions spread across 2 days covering topics critical for Hindu community

POLITICS

Politics plays a decisive role in modern societal discourse and governance. Many Hindus are highly educated and financially successful but do not participate in the political process, thus losing out to smaller but more politically-aware communities. The World Hindu Democratic Forum has the following goals:

- Hindu politicians should collaborate across party lines to safeguard Hindu interests & fight for Hindu human rights.
- Examples in Pakistan, Bangladesh, Bhutan, Kashmir, Kenya and Mozambique
- Develop support systems for Hindu politicians
- Encourage young people to get involved in politics and build leadership

- Profile pioneers in the community that have contributed to the public discourse especially in diaspora countries.




HINDU WOMEN AND HINDU YOUTH


- Engage the knowledge & talent of Hindu women for the Hindu resurgence and ensure maximum participation.


